### Sanctity of Human Life

The month of January is set aside to recognize the Sanctity of Human Life. This is a specific time when we encourage pastors and churches to educate and challenge their congregations. Bulletin inserts, speakers, and Mercy's current DVD are made available to our churches. In addition, this is also an opportunity to engage members of your church to support life through the ministry of Mercy. Pastors receive information from Mercy directly.

### Annual Fellowship Dinner

The dinner has been held at Glad Tidings AG Church. Reception begins at 6 PM; dinner will be served at 7 PM. The evening includes a time of fellowship, special music, testimony, and updates on the ministry. There is no charge for the meal, but an opportunity to support the ministry is presented. Watch for your invitation. RSVP is required. This is an adults only event. *Church reps. can help by putting announcements in their church bulletin, encouraging church members to attend, by inviting people to the banquet and hosting a table of eight.*

### Roslyn George Mother/Daughter Tea

Held each spring, the Roslyn George Mother/Daughter Tea event provides an opportunity for ladies (ages 13 and up) to learn about Mercy. Roslyn was a faithful servant of the Lord, a dear friend of those at Mercy, and enjoyed planning and participating in this event. We honor her memory in this small way. Ladies host a table of eight and provide the refreshments and decorations for their table. The food is served buffet style so that everyone can enjoy a variety. Mercy supplies tea, coffee, sugar, sugar substitutes, and creamer. A creative program and door prizes makes the evening fun for all. *Church reps. can help by promoting the event through bulletin announcements and flyers, hosting a table and encouraging others to host tables.*

### Walk for Life

The date of the Walk is usually on the second Saturday of September at various locations in Berks County. Participants are asked to raise pledges prior to the Walk and then join us for a 2-mile walk and refreshments. If people cannot come on the day of the Walk, they can still raise pledges and walk on their own. Some churches host a Walk for Life on a Sunday - Morning Worship Service is followed by a fellowship meal - covered dish or pizza supplied by the church. The congregation walks together supporting the ministry of Mercy with prayer in addition to raising financial support. Please note that display information is available. Prizes are awarded to the walker who raises the most in pledges. *Church reps. can help by promoting the Walk through bulletin inserts, announcements, flyers, encouraging others to walk and by forming a walk team to participate on the day of the Walk.*

### Crop for Life

Crop for Life, is a Scrap Booking event. Ladies are invited to come and fellowship with other women and work on their scrapbook projects. A Creative Memories representative is in attendance to help with any scrap booking needs. Dinner and snacks are provided. The cost, dates, and locations are always posted on Mercy's website. *Church reps. can help by promoting the Crop through bulletin announcements, flyers and, if you like to scrapbook, attend the event and invite your friends.
